#### Hope Lodge Program

American Cancer Society Hope Lodges provide support for cancer patients and their caregivers when they are the most vulnerable and without the anchor of familiar surroundings and relationships important to them. Private guest rooms with shared kitchen, eating area, laundry facilities and quiet spaces. The Hope Lodge provides a safe, supportive, home-like environment where cancer patients and their caregivers can stay when their best hope for a cure is receiving treatment in another city.

#### **Hotel Partnering Program**

The American Cancer Society partners with local hotels across the country to provide rooms for cancer patients and their caregivers when they must travel away from home for treatment.

The American Cancer Society Hotel Partner Program can help ease some of the emotional and financial concerns patients and their families are facing during an already challenging time.

### Look Good Feel Better Program

Cancer can rob a woman of her energy, appetite, and strength. But it doesn't have to take away her self-confidence. During Look Good Feel Better group workshops, volunteer beauty professionals teach simple techniques to women in active treatment to help them cope with skin and nail changes and hair loss. Workshop participants receive a free cosmetic kit and style tips. Group workshops are free and led by licensed volunteers beauty professionals.
